Name: Heavy Equipment 201

Summary: The goals of this course is to demonstrate the knowledge gained in the classroom and apply it in the field. You will gain operating experience driving the HE and practice hand signals as the Spotter. All aspects of operating the HE will include initial walk around to loading the tractor on the trailer. Additional operating experience will be available on a as needed basis to earn the HE 201 certification.

Upon Completion: Student will be certified to operate MDR HE. The Operator is expected to operate the HE within the guidelines and training from MDR. The Operator will work with the Team Leader and discuss operational goals to safely perform assignments. In addition, the operator will maintain all aspects of maintenance as needed as well as load and unload the HE from the trailer.

Topics:

- Hand signal review
- Capacities and limitations of equipment
- Safe Heavy Equipment operation and maintenance
- Daily pre operation walkaround inspection, servicing with the HE operator cards
- How to safely operate HE on the job site
- How to properly cool down, shut down and exit of HE
- Daily post operation walkaround, clean up and lubrication
- Loading and unloading HE from the MDR HE trailer

Length: 2 Hours. Operators with experience may demonstrate proficiency in a shorter time. Additional training may be necessary to achieve proficiency for certification.
