Name: Sawyer 201

Summary: Proper safety, maintenance, personal protective equipment, and correct technique are critical components of safe chainsaw operation. This training provides Sawyers with the proper procedures to safely and efficiently make dynamic and challenging cuts when deployed. Participants will be certified after being observed during training or deployment operating both the chainsaw and pole saw.

Upon Completion: The Sawyer will be certified as an operator and be able to perform maintenance and rehab on sawyer equipment. The Sawyer 201 may be requested to work as a Spotter or Operator to meet the needs of the mission.
